Busy, **Busy**

Congratulations to our students, who mostly continue to bring the best version of themselves to school, despite experiencing a very arduous year; or sometimes 2, for those students who were here in 2020. As mentioned previously, our teachers have been busily assessing students for end-of-year-reports and also planning for 2022. If you follow our Facebook page you will be aware that, thankfully, we are now able to welcome children on-site for Kindergarten orientation, with one fully vaccinated parent permitted on-site. This will allow face to face contact with our staff and also provide opportunities for our 2022 students to familiarise themselves with our school; and for parents to make any uniform purchases for their child. We look forward to welcoming our new and returning families, along with our new Kindergarten students later this term.

Pick-Up and Drop-Off

With the return to full-time face to face learning for students, once again we are experiencing high volumes of traffic around the front of our school. Unfortunately, an increase in traffic has also led to some inconsiderate and, at times, unsafe and disrespectful behaviour from drivers of vehicles on Coorumbung Road. The school has recently received complaints regarding verbal abuse from drivers; drivers stopping in *No Stopping* zones; drivers parking across residents' driveways; and drivers also stopping or parking within the School Crossing area. Our community is reflective of our school and, as a result, we ask that you observe etiquette and use consideration when dropping off and picking up your child/ren. As you are aware, and have been advised in the past, it is illegal to:

- Park across a driveway,
- Stop or park within a school crossing zone; OR
- Stop or park in the No Stopping zone

Please be assured that, should this continue, expect the ranger to be patrolling the areas outside the school and also expect infringements to be issued. Ultimately, all of the rules around the roads outside the school exist to keep pedestrians, including our students and staff, safe. Due to this, we would once again ask that, when dropping off and picking up your child/ren, please ensure you:

- Park in places that allow children a safe entry and exit point to and from your vehicle;
- Ensure that you encourage your child to use the footpaths correctly; and also use the designated school crossing zone.
- Meet your child on the school side of the street and cross safely using the school crossing zone, rather than waiting on the opposite side of the road.

Important- Presentation Day and Year 6 Farewell Update

Our annual presentation day will go ahead in our top COLA, under the following conditions:

- There will be one presentation ceremony, with students in K-2 and 3-6 in separate areas of the COLA
- Although we would love to see all of you attend, unfortunately, current COVID restrictions do not permit community audiences at Presentation days; therefore, at this point, unfortunately you will be unable to attend unless invited to perform a specific duty as part of the official presentation
- Invited guests of students will be required to RSVP to guarantee their attendance. If we are not expecting you, unfortunately you will not be permitted to attend
- Invited guests will be required to sign in and out, on arrival and departure, and must also complete a COVID declaration



As far as the Year 6 Farewell goes, we have been able to, at this stage, secure the Dora Creek Workers auditorium as a venue, under their strict COVID guidelines. This year, only Year 6 students, two family members and supervising staff will be permitted to attend this event. Thank you for your understanding in trying circumstances. We look forward to a great night!
